Dear Students,

Summer is right around the corner! This summer, CMC will be offering students the opportunity to engage deeply in research with faculty through two different programs, depending on the field of study. The Summer Research Program (SRP) provides research and intellectual opportunities for CMC students in the **social sciences, mathematical sciences, and humanities**. For summer research opportunities in the sciences, students apply through the Keck Science Department (contact Velda Yount, VYount@kecksci.claremont.edu).

With regards to SRP, students can participate in three ways:

1. Students can assist a faculty member in their research.
2. Students can develop an independent project and ask a faculty member to supervise the project.
3. Students can form a team of about four to work on a larger project under faculty supervision.

See the SRP [website](#) for more details about the application process and to apply. SRP will run for 8 weeks from May 23 to July 15, 2022. Students will be expected to work full time and will receive \$4800 for their participation.

This year, faculty are offering several different summer research experiences in their labs and research groups. You can see these opportunities [HERE](#). Students interested in any of these projects should talk with the professor running the project and develop an application that specifies work expectations and outcomes. Keep in mind that you can also reach out to faculty who are not listed on the website to gauge their interest and availability to supervise a summer research project. For both options, you will need to fill out the Faculty Approval Form and submit it with your application

The **deadline to submit an application is March 2nd, 2022**. These applications will be reviewed by a committee and decisions returned by the end of March.

A few additional details. You must be planning to be enrolled at CMC, Fall 2022 to apply. We are currently planning for an on-campus experience. We will update the community if this changes.
