Pablo Méndez Granadino is a violinist and community music workshop leader. He is the director of Armonía Cuscatleca, a nonprofit that offers music classes in underserved communities in El Salvador. He trained with Musicians Without Borders in the Netherlands and participated in “Soy Musica” a nation wide initiative to train public school teachers in El Salvador on how to utilize music education in their classrooms. He has shared the stage with artists Emmanuel, Larry Harlow, Charlie Zaa, Los Cojolites, Los Hermanos Flores, Adhesivo, The Outlaw Mariachi and Margarita Luna.
