The scholarship will pay up to \$1,000 for a summer instructional program in Modern Hebrew, Yiddish, or other languages relevant to Jewish Studies, but not taught at the Claremont Colleges.

Which students are eligible?

Which language programs are eligible?

Preference will be given to in-person programs offered through universities or recognized organizations.

How to apply?

Applications should include an explanation for how the language contributes to the student's academic program and a current transcript. Applications will be considered on a rolling basis, with approximately two awards being granted each year.
