Dear potential singers,

During the Covid pandemic semesters, the Joint Music Program has continued to offer a choir course in whatever way was then allowed. As we move into the fall semester, we anticipate two choirs meeting again in rehearsal and performance. We'd like to invite you to sing!

The Claremont Concert Choir (MUS 173) is an ensemble of sopranos, altos, tenors, and basses that will rehearse Mondays and Wednesdays 7:00-8:30 p.m. The Claremont Treble Singers (MUS 176) is a choir of sopranos and altos that will rehearse Mondays and Wednesdays 5:30-6:45 p.m. Each ensemble is open to students from all colleges. The prerequisite is the ability to sing melodies on pitch and to either read music at a basic or higher level OR to learn music by ear quickly. These prerequisites are determined in a modest, 10-minute audition with Professor Kamm that can be scheduled by emailing him (ckamm@scrippscollege.edu).
