Research and Teaching Assistant

The Berger Institute for Individual and Social Development and the Salvatori Center for Individual Freedom seeks several full-time research and teaching assistants from June 1 – July 31st. The position is in-person and requires residency on campus. (Although, some travel is allowed). Compensation is up to \$5000 for the 8 weeks. We will also provide housing.

Students will work with the directors to develop programming that promotes open inquiry, engagement in diverse viewpoints and experiences, and build programs to foster constructive and effective dialogue. Students will facilitate implementation of the Citizenship and Self-Government high school bridge program.

Responsibilities include:

- * Working with faculty supervisors to develop curriculum.
- * Assist in implementation of the all CSG activities between the 18th and the 29th;
- * Leading small-group discussions of readings on liberalism and democracy, polarization, free speech, inequality, diversity, populism, and so forth;
- * Working with high school students on their writing;
- * Mentoring students on the college admissions and transition process;
- * Generally providing RA supervision;
- * There are also opportunities to help plan the program's curriculum, provide technical and administrative support, and participate in field-trip events during the 2022-2023 academic year.
