Christine Vachon is an Independent Spirit Award and Gotham Award winner who co-founded powerhouse Killer Films with partner Pamela Koffler in 1995. Over nearly three decades, they have produced more than 100 films, including some of the most celebrated and important American independent features: KIDS, I SHOT ANDY WARHOL, HAPPINESS, BOYS DON'T CRY, HEDWIG AND THE ANGRY INCH, FAR FROM HEAVEN, ONE HOUR PHOTO, STILL ALICE, CAROL, BEATRIZ AT DINNER, and DARK WATERS. In television, Vachon executive-produced the Emmy and Golden Globe-awarded miniseries MILDRED PIERCE for HBO as well as the Emmy Award-winning limited series HALSTON for Netflix. Recent releases include Zach Braff's A GOOD PERSON (MGM), starring Florence Pugh and Morgan Freeman, Celine Song's PAST LIVES (A24), which premiered at the Sundance Film Festival and screened in competition at the Berlin International Film Festival, and Rebecca Miller's SHE CAME TO ME (Vertical), starring Peter Dinklage, Marisa Tomei, and Anne Hathaway.
