Join us for a conversation on the Boycott, Divest, Sanction (BDS) movement. Over the past year, BDS has seen a massive resurgence in the US and around the world, particularly on college campuses. What is the history of boycott campaigns both regionally and globally? How does the BDS movement fit into this history? Who are the stakeholders behind it? Who gets to implement its policies and why? How should we best understand the positions outlined by both advocates and opponents of such campaigns? Why has it become such a flashpoint political issue? When are these sorts of political actions justified? Should universities boycott, divest, and sanction Israel?

For this event, The Open Academy will be hosting Professors David Lloyd and Yuval Avnur. Professor Lloyd is a Distinguished Professor of English Emeritus at the University of California Riverside, working primarily on Irish history and colonialism, postcolonial, settler-colonial theory, aesthetics, and poetry. Professor Avnur is a Professor of Philosophy at Scripps College, whose main focuses include Epistemology, Skepticism, Religion, and Echo Chambers.
