

Auditions are open to students of all levels, including those who have never studied music before.

**Sign up sheets** will be posted on the door of PAC 138 the week of Monday, January 13, 2025 at the Scripps Performing Arts Center for interview/auditions that will be available on the following days/times:

- Thursday, January 23, 2025 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
- Friday, January 24, 2025 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
- Friday, January 24, 2025 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm

If you are interested in lessons, you must meet with us. **No one may pre-register for piano lessons until after you receive permission from the department.** Beginners will be interviewed and evaluated. For intermediate – advanced students, please bring one prepared piece to play and be ready to do a little sight reading.

We offer group lessons for one hour a week. Most private lessons are a half hour. They both earn you .5 credit (HMC 1.5 cc).

Our piano program expectation is that each student practices an average of one hour daily and makes significant progress during the semester. Grades will be based on your progress.
