

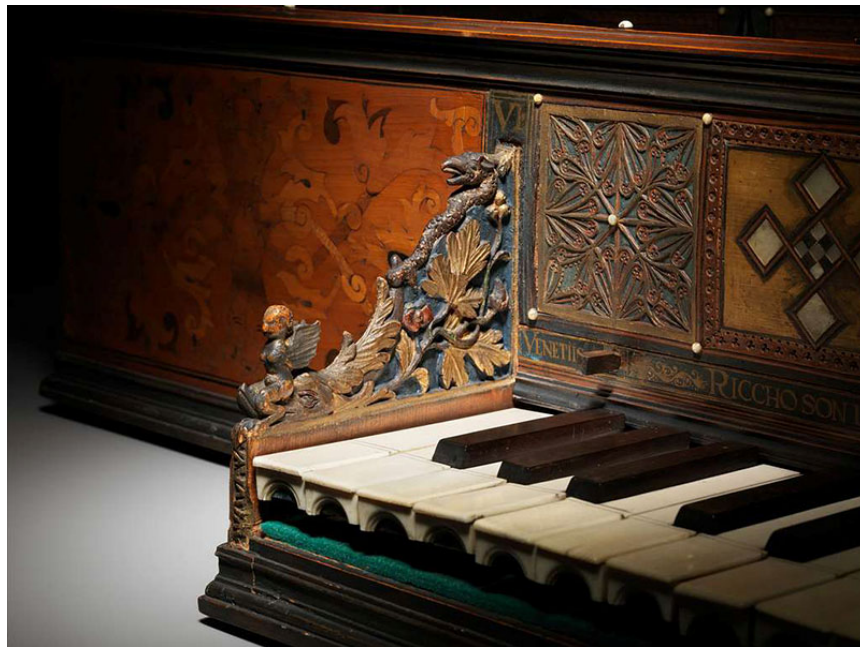

The virginal is a small but versatile sixteenth-century keyboard, often associated with intimate settings and a great variety of rarely heard music of the early Baroque. Moss will perform works by William Byrd, John Bull, Orlando Gibbons, Martin Peerson, Jan Sweelinck, Thomas Tomkins, and Jim Fox, and Moss will be joined by Huang to perform one of the great “Mystery Sonatas” by Heinrich Biber.
