Join us on Friday, April 4 from 7:00-8:30 PM at The Motley Coffeehouse at Scripps College, where Nodutdol will be holding a teach-in on the **history of Korean resistance** and the ongoing struggle for Korea's national liberation through the lens of the 4.3 Jeju Uprising (April 3, 1948). Information around the Jeju uprising was heavily suppressed for decades by the South Korean government with the support of the US military. The teach-in will conclude with an overview of Nodutdol's "US Out of Korea" campaign, tying in lessons from the worker-led struggle of the Jeju Uprising that began in 1947, peaked in 1948, and continued after the Korean War.
