




Worldbuilding 3000 is a collective learning symposium held from April 2 - 9, 2025 in Salathe Gallery.

Comprised of a trio of workshops, artist talks, and an installation by Marvin James, this symposium culminates their role as Pitzer College's 2024-25 Artist-Activist in Residence.

Presented by the ITS-IN-SCOPE Freedom Institute, Worldbuilding 3000 resembles a college course, institutional symposium, and gallery exhibition. Our intention is bringing learners from within and beyond the institution together to center Black and Indigenous experiences, hold space for intimate curiosities, and continue to build desired futures amidst our present realities.

Hosted on-campus at Salathe Gallery (McConnell Center 110), each session is open to the public, RSVP only, free to attend, and limited to 14 participants.
