

An Exhibition On Wheels + Block Party Reception

(re)Location: Real and Imaginative Displacement is a pop-up exhibition on wheels organized by the Pitzer College Art Galleries and Gallery Fellows in partnership with the Racial Justice Initiative.

The land the Claremont Colleges occupy is tied to a long history of displacement, from the violent erasure of Indigenous Tongva people by settler-colonizers to the buyouts of Mexican-American families who lived in El Barrio, the neighborhood southeast of the Claremont Colleges, to make way for the colleges' expansion. Today, mass deportations spearheaded by the new administration, the ongoing genocide in Gaza, and climate catastrophes such as the LA fires remind us of the fragility of home and belonging.

This exhibition seeks to explore themes of home, belonging, community, displacement, migration, and change through historical and contemporary narratives. Curated by the Gallery Fellows, the exhibition is drawn from material, visual, textual, and audio responses to the following prompts:

- How do landscapes and objects hold memory?
- What object(s) would you prioritize in an emergency or evacuation?
- What gives you a sense of belonging or community?
- Where do you feel at home? Has that changed?
- Reflect on Claremont's history or your own experience of displacement.

A lively, block party-style reception with an artist-led workshop bringing together the 7C community will accompany the mobile U-Haul galleries.
