Stein is the Cone Wagner Professor of Law at the University of Florida Levin College of Law and affiliate faculty for the University's AI2 Center, internationally recognized for her research on energy law and policy, as well as the intersection of artificial intelligence, energy, and environmental law. She serves on UF's AI Working Group in AI Ethics and Policy and the Florida Climate Institute, as well as the Association of American Law Schools' Natural Resources and Energy Law and Environmental Sections. Popular Science named Professor Stein one of the "Visionary Thinkers" of 2022 for her work on algorithms and the climate crisis.
