

I would like to inform you of a great summer research opportunity for students majoring in neuroscience. Intercollegiate Neurosciences of the Claremont Colleges will be offering five summer research fellowships during the summer of 2026 for Neuroscience majors across the five colleges (Pomona, Scripps, Harvey Mudd, Claremont-McKenna & Pitzer). Each fellowship is for the amount of \$5000.00 and will be awarded to five students each to embark on a 10-week research placement in select laboratories throughout the greater Los Angeles/Southern California area. Institutions that have participated in our Summer Research Fellowship Program include the University of Southern California Neuroscience Program, City of Hope Neurosciences Division, Loma Linda University, University of California, Los Angeles, University of California at Irvine, Drew University School of Medicine, Huntington Medical Institute and others. I anticipate more sites will be added to the list in the near future. Placements will encompass various specialties in neuroscience that include clinical neuroscience, cellular-molecular neuroscience, systems neuroscience, neurobiology, neurophysiology, cognitive neuroscience & neuroimaging. Students also are given the option of procuring their own placement at a lab of their choice. Summer fellowship research also has the added benefit of potentially evolving into a senior thesis project through the Pomona College Department of Neuroscience and the Department of Natural Science Neuroscience major.

On Monday, December 1st at 6:00 PM via Zoom a general informational meeting will be held for neuroscience majors who are interested pursuing summer research through our fellowship program. In this meeting we will go over the details of the prospective placements, application procedures, deadlines and I will take any questions that you may have.
